Colonial Woods, Port Huron, held a baptismal service Aug. 25 at Fort Gratiot County Park. (Rev. Phil Whetstone)

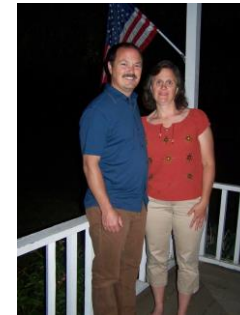


Colonial Woods Baptismal Service
