The facility includes the sanctuary, a fellowship hall and a basement which houses offices and classrooms, including a youth room.



A nursery and kitchen are also located within the building. A pavilion was built in the summer of 2024 and is used for outdoor ministry.

Beginnings: Lamotte Missionary Church began in 1887 when a group of Christians who migrated from the Ontario Province started meeting weekly, then became affiliated with the Ontario District of the Mennonite Brethren in Christ Church. The congregation met in a school building until they built their first building in 1890. That building was used until the current building was completed in 1970.

Training Leaders: LMC has a strong history of raising up and sending out workers under the Great Commission. Past members have served, and currently serve, as missionaries (both within the U.S. and outside), pastors, Christian educators and administrators within the Missionary Church.
